Students can access pre-recorded virtual workshops to help students prepare for the application process.

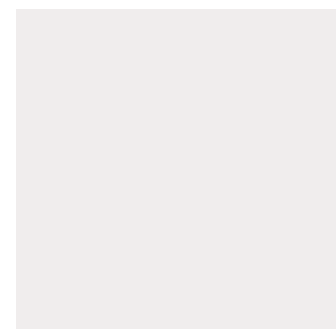
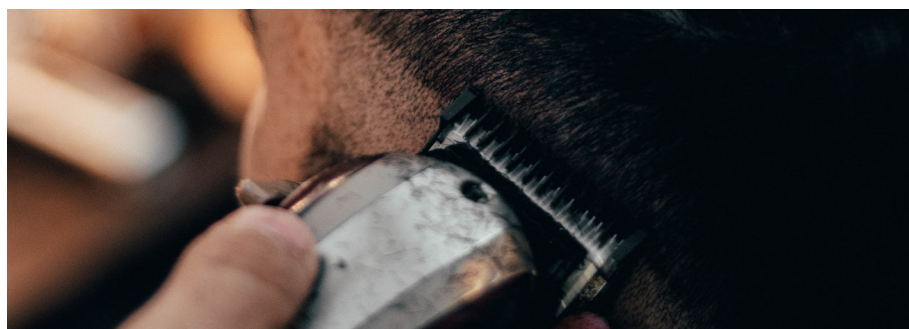
