‘Creating Careers Live’ with Health Education – England – Years 11/12

Four exciting events are taking place between May and July as part of ‘Creating Careers Live’ with Health Education England.

Although students may not have a specific interest in all of these careers, an understanding of the wider NHS and multi-disciplinary healthcare is invaluable for interviews and something NHS Trusts look for. All students who attend can receive 1-2-1 follow up support, they’re also given pre and post work to build the relevant skills for NHS careers.

All careers covered are those which the NHS is actively recruiting for in the North West and considers a priority – meaning great future employment opportunities.

Any Y11 or Y12 students who attend will be invited to an on campus visit at the University of Liverpool, focused on supporting them with their healthcare applications. This is going to be invite only, for the students who have attended a webinar.

May 19th - Dental Careers

Covering dental nurses, dental therapists, dental techs and dental hygienists.

Useful for any students considering any dental careers including dentistry, as this is a competitive course and students should take advantage of any opportunities to gain a wider knowledge of the dental sector. These roles may be of interest for students studying Biology or Human Biology, or students with a particular interest in methodical or technical work.

June 9th - Pharmacy

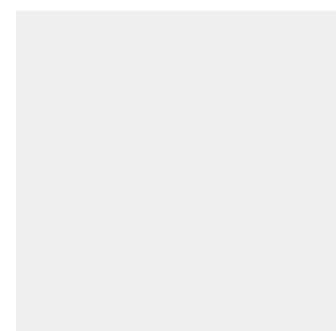
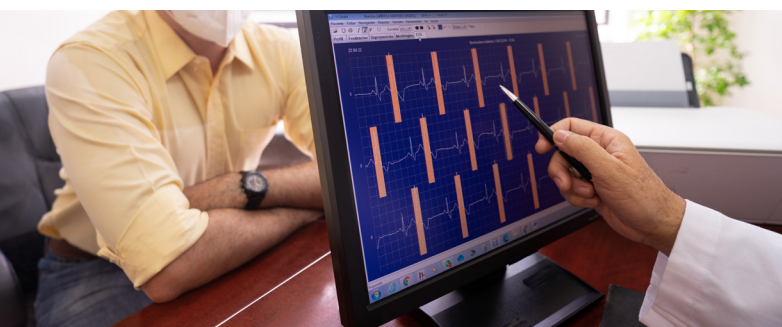
Covering Pharmacist, Pharmacy Assistant, Pharmacy Technician.

May be of interest to students studying Biology, Chemistry or with an interest in Biochemistry, as well as students with an interest in primary care roles, or roles in a less clinical, more community based role.

June 23rd - Estates and Facilities

Covering the non-clinical and non-medical careers in the NHS – estates and facilities.

Could be useful for students unsure of their career direction.



July 7th - Healthcare Science

Covering careers available in Healthcare Science, including roles such as Clinical Bioinformatics, Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Biomedical Engineering and Physiological Sciences.

May be of interest to students taking Biology, Chemistry and Human Biology at A Level, Applied Science BTEC or Healthcare Science T Level
