Apprenticeships – Year 11

Jaguar Land Rover (JLR) are currently asking for expressions of interest in relation to a Level 3 advanced apprenticeship (Starting in 2023). Manufacturing and automotive pathways are available.

Duration: a four year course – first year in full time education with Make UK (Liverpool) before transitioning to JLR (four days per week) and also attending the training centre one day per week.

Qualifications required - Maths and English GCSE at level 4 or higher, plus three other GCSEs at level 4 or higher.
